ROAD CLOSURES
FOR
THE BACCHANAL RUN

SATURDAY, AUGUST 02nd, 2025

The Ministry of Public Works and Environment wishes to inform motorists that the Bacchanal Run will take place on Saturday, August 02nd, 2025 and will require multiple road closures at the times listed below.

There will be one route to this event that will require road closures. See here below for the route and when the event time will take place. Motorists are requested to avoid this route during the times specified.

ROUTE 1: Start time 7:00 am until 9:30 pm and roads to be closed.

Commencing on Frog Lane then travel in a northerly direction to Palmetto Road, then turn left and travel in a westerly direction along Palmetto Road and Marsh Folly Road to Dutton Avenue and turn left on Dutton Avenue and travel to Bernard Park Field.

The procession route will end at Dutton Avenue.

DUTTON AVENUE From 9:00 am, Saturday 02nd August 2025, until 12:00 pm, Sunday 3rd August 2025 will be closed to all traffic.

FROG LANE From 7:00 am, Saturday 02nd August 2025, until 12:00 pm, Sunday 3rd August 2025 will be closed to all traffic.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: Residents in these areas are encouraged to follow instructions by the Bermuda Police

Service, and Traffic Marshals on duty for this event. Residents will be provided access as necessary, and give participants passage to move along the road closure routes. Residents are asked to avoid driving along the parade route whilst participants are on route.

PARKING:

There will be no parking restrictions for this event. Motorists are permitted to park in designated parking bays along any part of the event. Additionally, motorists must not block the event routes or impede the participants.

In addition, the Bermuda Police Service; are hereby authorized to “Close-Off” streets or portions of streets and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologizes for any inconvenience that may result.
